Introduction to Relief Printmaking (NEW!)

A new class in our new print studio! Using our printing presses, participants will explore making images in limited editions through linoleum cuts, wood block and collograph. All levels of experience are welcome; space is limited. Tuesdays, 12:30 to 3 p.m. or 7 to 9:30 p.m. Instructor: Chuck Miley. Fee: \$250, plus a materials fee of \$15 due the first day of class. Extra studio time is included.

Art with a Master

Ballet II


Ages 5-6, Wednesdays, 4:30-5:30 p.m. Fee: \$85.
