

RESOLUTION IN HONOR OF LEE BOSWELL-MAY AND NAMING ROAD "BOZ WAY"

WHEREAS, Lee Boswell-May, a lifelong resident of the Township of South Orange Village ("South Orange"), was

- An advocate for human rights
- A historian for the African-American experience in our area
- An active supporter of the South Orange Performing Arts Center
- A curator of Jazz in the Loft at SOPAC
- A long-term trustee of the Community Coalition on Race
- A member of the Newark Bethany Baptist Church Jazz Vespers Committee and Newark Bethany Baptist Church Choir as well as a Board member of Arts for Kids, Inc. and
- A relentless cheerleader for jazz, music, arts and her love of South Orange; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2019-21 provides that the Board of Trustees shall be responsible for naming roads and streets within South Orange; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees wishes to remember Lee Boswell-May for her tireless contributions to the musical, artistic, civic, humanitarian and social improvement, culture and benefit of South Orange; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustee wishes to give the name "Boz Way" to the access road running between Mead Street and South Orange Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Township of South Orange Village that the access road running between Mead Street and South Orange Avenue shall hereafter be named and referred to as "Boz Way" in honor of Lee Boswell-May and to take all actions consistent therewith.
