RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXTENSION OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH ORANGE VILLAGE, SETON HALL UNIVERSITY AND DR. JUAN A. RIOS, JR. FOR SERVICES RELATED TO THE SOUTH ORANGE CARE & COMMUNITY JUSTICE PROJECT

WHEREAS, on January 25, 2021, the Board of Trustees for the Township of South Orange Village adopted Resolution 2021-019 authorizing the execution of an agreement with Seton Hall University whereby Seton Hall University provided the services of Dr. Juan Rios in connection with the Care & Community Justice Project; and

WHEREAS, the agreement authorized by Resolution 2021-019 was of limited duration and has expired by its own terms at the conclusion of the spring 2021 semester; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to extend his service to this project for the fall semester and reduce Dr. Rios' instruction credit requirement to Seton Hall and release him for 3 credits in the fall 2021 semester; and

WHEREAS, South Orange agrees to reimburse Seton Hall for 1/6 of Dr. Rios' annual salary for the fall 2021 semester, in an amount not to exceed \$15,000 and Seton Hall shall fund the remainder of Dr. Rios' salary and all benefit costs for the fall 2021 semester.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Township of South Orange Village that:

1. The annexed Extension of the Memorandum of Understanding or document in substantially the same form and content is hereby approved.
2. The Village President or the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to execute an Extension of Memorandum of Understanding or document in substantially the same form and content.

EXTENSION TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BY AND BETWEEN
TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH ORANGE VILLAGE AND SETON HALL UNIVERSITY
PERMITTING DR. JUAN A. RIOS, JR. TO SERVE AS A CONSULTANT FOR THE
SOUTH ORANGE COMMUNITY CARE & JUSTICE PROJECT

Whereas, in January 2021, the Township of South Orange Village ("South Orange") and Seton Hall University ("Seton Hall") executed a Memorandum of Understanding permitting Dr. Juan A. Rios, Jr. ("Dr. Rios") to serve as a Consultant to the Community Care & Justice Project; and

Whereas, in or about June 2021, the Village and Dr. Rios extended his service as a Consultant to the Community Care & Justice Project during the summer months (during which he was not being employed by Seton Hall); and

Whereas, Dr. Rios resumed his employment with Seton Hall for the fall semester and the parties wish to further extend his service to this project and reduce Dr. Rios' instruction credit requirement to Seton Hall and release him for 3 credits in the fall 2021 semester; and

Whereas, South Orange agrees to reimburse Seton Hall for 1/6 of Dr. Rios' annual salary for the fall 2021 semester, in an amount not to exceed \$15,000 and Seton Hall shall fund the remainder of Dr. Rios' salary and all benefit costs for the fall 2021 semester.

Now, therefore, the Parties execute this Extension to the Memorandum of Understanding to memorialize their continued desire and intent to successfully implement the Community Care & Justice Project.

1. Dr. Rios presently serves on the academic staff of Seton Hall University and has requested a 3 credit release in the fall 2021 semester to continue his service as a Project Consultant to the South Orange Community Care & Justice Project.
2. Seton Hall University, recognizing the value and timeliness of this project as well as the benefit of continued collaboration with South Orange, wishes to grant the requested credit release provided South Orange reimburses Seton Hall for 1/6 of Dr. Rios' annual salary, with Seton Hall funding the remainder of Dr. Rios' salary and all benefit costs for the fall 2021 semester.
3. Seton Hall shall invoice South Orange for Dr. Rios' services and South Orange agrees to reimburse Seton Hall for 1/6 of Dr. Rios' annual salary, with Seton Hall funding the remainder of Dr. Rios' salary and all benefit costs, during his tenure serving as Project Director for the South Orange Community Care & Justice Project in a total amount not to exceed \$15,000.00.
4. Term: This Extension to the Memorandum of Understanding shall commence on August 30, 2021, and shall continue to and include December 31, 2021, unless it is terminated by either party by written notice 30 days prior to December 31, 2021.
5. All other terms of the the Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in full and effect.
